

Carroll County Farm Bureau 2011 Scholarship Application
Deadline May 1, 2011

The Carroll County Farm Bureau will offer two \$2,000.00 scholarships. Applicants must be high school seniors starting college in the fall of 2011 or full time college students at any community college, technical school or four-year institution. Preference will be given to an agriculture major, the second scholarship will be given to any major. Applicants or their parents/guardians **MUST** be members of the Carroll County Farm Bureau.

Selection will be made by a committee designated by the Carroll County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. To apply, students must return the attached application form, their most recent transcript and a resume including community service work and an **unsigned** (**NO personal information, for example: school names, 4-H clubs, etc**) essay on this topic. "Since Agriculture is often blamed for excessive pollutants, how can farmers educate state and federal officials, environmentalist, and the general public about conservation practices that are already taking place on their farms". The essay should not exceed two pages using minimum of a 12 point font size. The selection committee will evaluate each essay anonymously. No student can receive this scholarship more than four times.

The Carroll County Farm Bureau office **MUST** receive applications by May 1, 2011. Scholarships will be awarded to winning applicants prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Winners will also be recognized at the Miss Carroll County Farm Bureau Contest at the Carroll County 4-H and FFA fair. The winner's scholarship check will be made out to the student **and** the college. The committee reserves the right to interview scholarship applicants if they feel it necessary for determination of winners. Any personal information appearing in the essay would disqualify the application.
