



***Trip to Valley Forge, PA***

The motor coach will leave the Ag Center in Westminster, MD at 7:30am.

We will arrive at Valley Forge National Historical Park (the site of the 1777-78 winter encampment of the Continental Army under General George Washington) at approximately 10:30am. We will begin our tour of this national historical park with a guide upon arrival. Our tour will be completed at approximately 12:45pm. We will then proceed to a "sit down lunch" at the Winberie's Restaurant – menu choices are listed below. After lunch we will then tour the new American Treasure Museum. This is a museum of expansive American memorabilia. Ten of thousands of items are displayed over three acres. A guided tram tour (with little walking) will take us through decades of American history. At the conclusion of this tour we will depart for home, with a fast food stop along the way. We plan to return to the Ag Center in Westminster at approximately 7:30pm.
