The Cecil Soil Conservation District is honored to contribute to three student's secondary education goals and give back to the agricultural community across our county.

Student Eligibility:

- The **Paul A. Raech Scholarship** will be available to high school senior who is a resident of Cecil County or will graduate from a Cecil County high school (public, private, home school), and is starting an Associate or Bachelor Degree Program.

and

- The **Floyd Allred and Edgar “Duty” Hevelow Scholarships** will be available to a current college undergraduate who has demonstrated the desire to major in natural resources and/or conservation related degree program (2 year technical, Associate or Bachelor’s degree).

One (1) high school student will receive a \$1,250.00 scholarship and Two (2) current college undergraduates will receive a \$2,500.00 scholarship. Scholarships are to be awarded via letter from the District and will provide the details for the process of disbursement directly to the college institution which the student is attending.

The Cecil Soil Conservation District Scholarship Committee will select the recipients from applications with all identifying information redacted.
