For Agricultural Curriculum Majors

Frederick County Farm Bureau Scholarships have been established for **Frederick County youth majoring in an agricultural area of study**. These scholarships are sponsored by Frederick County Farm Bureau, Frederick County Farm Bureau Women, and Frederick County Young Farmers.

Awards will be made annually and applicants may reapply; however, applicants can only apply a maximum of four years.

WHO MAY APPLY: Graduating high school seniors planning to attend an accredited undergraduate college or university, accredited vocational or trade school or community college, or students currently attending any of the above. *The applicant must major in an agricultural area of study.*

CRITERIA:

1. A student majoring in an agricultural area of study.
2. Demonstrate academic achievement—excellence in effort and performance. A current high school or college transcript must be submitted with the application.
3. Demonstrate outstanding service to community and involvement in leadership and extracurricular activities.
4. Clear statement of educational goals.
5. Financial need will be considered, but it is not the primary factor in selecting winners.
6. Provide two letters of reference.
7. Complete the application form by the designated time. All applications must be typed.
